**Mass Mutual Life Insurance.** Sometimes there actually is a “free lunch.” In this case, the “lunch” is \$50,000 of life insurance. When someone purchases insurance, he/she is betting that something bad will happen to them while the policy is in force; the insurance company is betting that something bad won’t happen. Usually you have to buy insurance; in this instance, there is no cost to you.

Mass Mutual is offering \$50,000 of life insurance that is absolutely free. LifeBridge, which is an insurance policy, offered by MassMutual, is free life insurance intended to help you provide an education for your children if you die before they complete their schooling. Under the policy, MassMutual will issue a \$50,000 life insurance policy to you at no cost for a period of 10 years. If you die within that period, the \$50,000 is used to cover the educational expenses of your children. And your children have 10 years after your death or until age 13 to use this benefit.

You are eligible to apply for LifeBridge if you are:

- Between the ages of 19-42.
- The parent or legal guardian of one or more dependent children under age 18
- A permanent, legal resident of the United States
- Currently employed either full or part time with a total family income of \$10,000-\$40,000 per year
- In good health
