

A few things we like all of our volunteers to know:

- **Volunteers under the age of 18, must be accompanied by a parent or legal guardian. For insurance and legal reasons, no one under the age of 16 is permitted to work at a Habitat work site. NO EXCEPTIONS!**

- **Smoking is only allowed outside the fence at the construction sites. Handling materials or operating power tools is extremely dangerous and will be grounds for dismissal from the worksite.**

- **We ask our volunteers to arrive at 7:45 a.m. to receive instructions so work can begin at 8:00 a.m. We also ask our volunteers to commit to working an entire day, ending roughly at 3:30 pm and that everyone helps with cleaning up at day's end so the site is prepared for the next workday.**

- **Please be sure to wear appropriate work clothes and boots or sturdy shoes to the work site. Sandals and open-toed shoes are strictly prohibited at the worksites! You may also want to consider bringing in your own bug repellent, sunscreen, and a wide-brimmed hat, which will be very handy in warm weather. In the winter, please dress in layers including gloves and extra socks to keep your fingers and toes warm!!**

- **Tools and gloves are provided but you can bring the following tools, only if you have them:**

Hammer	25' tape measure
Pencil	Safety glasses
Nail apron	Work gloves
Unbreakable coffee mug	Utility knife with several sharp blades

- **Please be sure to mark all your tools and other personal items with your name for easy identification.**

- **Habitat will provide coffee for the morning break. Snack is *sometimes* provided by volunteers and sometimes provided by your work group.**

- **We ask volunteers to bring their own lunches and drinking water. You will need lots of water on warm days. Drinking water may not be available at some of the sites.**
